The time separating the **Stegosaurus** and the **Tyrannosaurus** is more than the time separating the Tyrannosaurus and us.



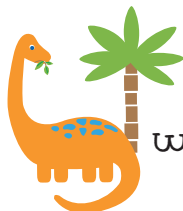
